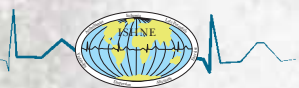

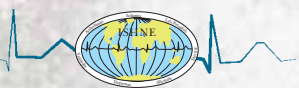

## Language

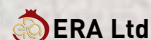
The official language of the Congress is English.
